Lefort iii can be modified in various ways just like a zygomatic osteotomy so there is not one answer to your question. The user "earl25" on jawsurgeryforums had a "true" zygomatic osteotomie i.e one where the orbitals (including the part of the maxilla that makes up the lower orbital wall and midface just below the eyes) were mobilized it did not, however, touch his jaws because his bite were fine.

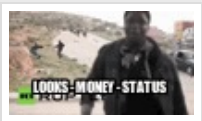


From right to left: i, ii and iii. The modified lefort iii leaves the upper jaw in place and only moves the orbitals forward, so the middle area in red you see including the bone behind the nose and the upper jaw stays in place. I would benfit from this as well as my jaws are fine but my orbitals are somewhat recessed. Are you in the same situation heilsa?

To clarify Lefort ii includes the area from a Lefort 1 plus the middle part of the midface. A Lefort iii includes all of that plus the lower and lateral orbitals, a modified Lefort iii leaves out everything form the previous two leforts and only moves the orbitals.

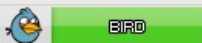

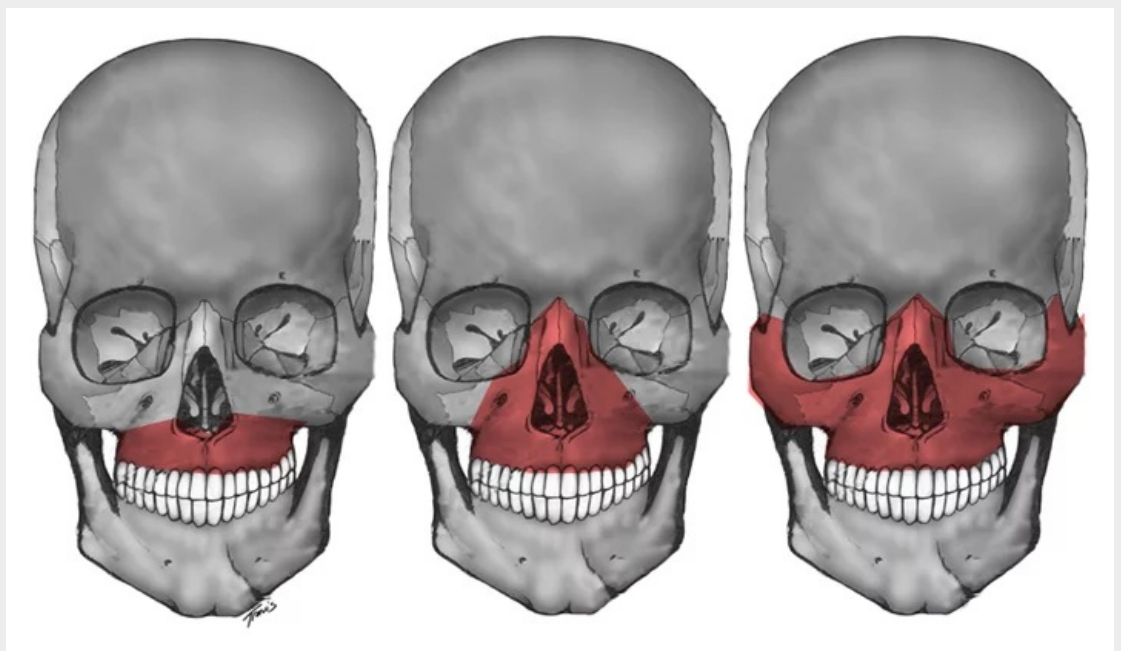

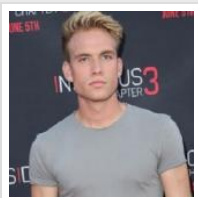

Zygomatic osteotomies doesn't move the orbitals only a lefort iii does that -that's why it is sometimes called a "true zygomatic osteotomy" because it actually mobilizes the whole zygomatic area.

To be fair there are so many types of ZO's that I can't keep track of them all -what I know of the "sandwich" type is that it seals the osteomatic cut with HA-paste hence the nickname "sandwich". However from what I've heard this won't give us what we're after for a couple of reasons. First: the projection isn't enough, the effectiveness of all osteotomies is limited by just how much bone that is actually moved and the ZO surgeries just doesn't involve enough skeletal tissue to make a big change in the overall structure. Second: the cut is done below the orbital to protect the important visual nerves that run through it look:



We want augmentation around line A or even higher but the ZO cuts at B thus creating a lower more "round" cheekbone that looks great on women but bad on men. If you need orbital augmentation like me ZO won't help at all, and considering what I just wrote I am sceptical it is a good option for augmenting zygos at all actually. There's more to learn though.

Implants is the other option to really augment the orbitals but the results will never look as good/natural as actually moving the bone forward (not saying it will be bad necessarily) and it comes with all the usual risks of foreign implants: bone loss, movement, infection, bad aesthetic result due to aging etc. I mean if the risks with a lefort iii aren't much worse in the hand of a skilled surgeon then why would anyone go with implants?

This advances the actual jaw as well, though, something that Earl didn't have done. **Here's another "modified" Lefort III** that diverges from the formula; it mobilizes the orbitals and the nasal bone in an oblique cut, but it leaves the upper jaw untouched—which is in turn advanced in a separate, simultaneous Lefort I procedure.

Something like this would be optimal to get everything done in one step, could they only also increase the width of the zygomas at the same time; but that'd probably put undue stress on the surgeons.

Is there even any standard?

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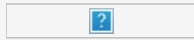
Nigger, I'm looking into it now and it seems really promising for us with negative vector and any lack of midface projection.
