Both gifs have the same anterior advancement — measured by the length of the resulting posterior gap — but in one morph the maxilla is rotated counterclockwise with a corresponding impaction for a proper bite. There's obviously nothing wrong with the jaw in the before-images, but they're just morphs I made to get my bearings.

From the reading I've done there seems to be some aesthetic advantages — if you're a candidate — with a CCW rotation, e.g. improved mandible angle, less resulting mass at the base of the nose, a shorter lower third and a more curled, aesthetic philtrum (?).

Whenever I research my problems I keep bumping into posts by Kyra all over the web, which is understandable given that our issues are (were?) quite similar.

Am I understanding this right? Surgerycels please respond.


Figure 6 - A counterclockwise maxillomandibular advancement (CCW-MMA) is depicted with pre surgery on the left and post surgery on the right. Note in the post surgical photograph the balanced profile without nasal problems associated with S-MMA.




Figure 42. Case 5 C.B. Pre-surgical: frontal view (d) profile view (e) and occlusion (f). Post-operative results: frontal view (g) profile view (h) and occlusion (i).

Legit. this is what I'm getting except my maxilla is also slightly retruded.


the way impaction works is that the **bone behind the sof ttissue** (**skin**) is grown too vertically for the amount of soft tissue there. that's why you kind of see this hollowness in the cheek region in the before picture. this hollowness is there because the **soft tissue** is being stretched out(down) by the extra vertically grown bone behind it. in a lefort 1 impaction, the bottom portion of the maxilla is detached from the skull and a **slither of bone** is removed and the surgeon can either rotate CCW or keep the plane in which the teeth rest at, depending on the soft tissue profile of the patient. this extra vertical bone growth in the maxilla is also why she cannot close her lips at rest before (wthiout straining which would also affect chin aesthetics). in addition, removing a sliver of the maxilla will also affect the aesthetics of the lower jaw; when the maxilla rises, so do the teeth attached to it. This alleviates "long face syndrome" (where the lower jaw is locked in a clockwise rotation by the teeth because of the extra downward growth in the maxilla) by letting the lower jaw auto rotate in to a higher and more forward position (by meeting into a new higher position of the teeth in the maxilla). overall, you can see in the before and after that its as if her whole bottom third rotated counterclockwise, up and forward.

<u>tldr</u>: bone = hand soft tissue/skin = glove

hand fits into glove badly because it is too big/small. impaction makes sure the proportions of the hand are adjusted so that it is the perfect fit for the glove



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it depends on your facial structure and midface length, but you're seeing this because people with shorter midfaces(more forward grown) tend to have a maxilla that fits in between the cheekbones. this picture of david gandy is a good way to explain this if it is hard for you to visualize what I'm saying:



the **bottom blue lines** is where gandys cheekbones end, and the red lines illustrate roughly where his maxilla sits. since his maxilla fits "inbetween" his cheekbones it <u>stretches the skin in the green part</u> forward, given that the maxilla is not retruded and forward grown and sits at a high angle. the good news is
